Rogich Student Expectations

- Follow school-wide expectations as laid out in your student agenda
- Be respectful to your peers, teachers and other adults
- If you need help solving a problem seek advice from your teachers, counselors, social workers or administrators

Bullying/Cyberbullying

- Rogich Middle School has a zero tolerance policy for any form of bullying/cyberbullying
- Think before you send a text, post a comment on social media
- Once you have said or posted a comment you cannot take it back or delete it
- Students who bully other students will be subject to disciplinary actions

Attendance Policies

- An absence note must be turned into the attendance clerk within 3 days
 - Absence notes should include the student's name and student number, date(s), reason for absence and parent/guardian signature
- See your planner for further information
- No absence notes will be taken after 3 days
- 10 unexcused absences will result in denial of credit

TARDY POLICY

- Tardy Policy will begin the 2nd week of school
- Students who are Tardy will be sent to the Deans' Office and placed on RPC
- Parents will have to meet with a dean before you are allowed to return to school

Dean's Detention

- Students who run on campus, participate in horse play, climb in the planters will receive a Dean's Detention
- Students who violate the Dress Code Policy will receive a Dean's Detention
- Students who carry their backpack to class or lunch
- Students who have a 2nd item confiscated
- Dean's Detention is served from 3:30 – 4:15 PM

Cell Phones

- Students may not be on their cell phones once the 9 AM bell rings
- Students who are on their phone following the 9 AM bell, will have their phone confiscated and sent to the Dean's Office
- Cell phones must be stored in your locker and placed on silent mode
- Parents must pick-up your cell phone, students will not be allowed to pick them up
- Rogich MS teachers and administration are not responsible for lost, stolen or broken Cell Phones
- Bring Cell Phones and use them at your own risk

ChromeBooks

- Each student will be issued a ChromeBook
- Please follow your teacher's guidelines regarding ChromeBook use in their classroom
- Misuse of the ChromeBook will result in confiscation and a parent or guardian must pick-up your ChromeBook
- Camera/video functions are not permitted on campus. Recording, posting and/or sharing pictures/video may result in disciplinary action (this includes your cell phone)

Lockers

- Students assigned a locker must store their backpacks in their lockers
- DO NOT SHARE YOUR LOCKER/COMBO WITH ANYONE
- Students are responsible for the contents of their locker
- Student lockers are the property of CCSD and can be searched at any time
- Use your lockers before school, during lunch and after school. Plan accordingly, you do not have time to use your locker between each class

Loitering

- You are NOT permitted to loiter at the park behind the leisure center, the leisure center or at Palo Verde before or after school
- Student may be trespassed by School Officials, City Officials and/or Law Enforcement
- Disciplinary action may be taken by Rogich Administration

Dress Code

- All students must be in proper dress code as explained on pages 8 & 9 of the students planner
- All students on the Rogich MS campus have been informed of the dress code. No warnings will be given
- Violation of the dress code will result in a Dean's Detention and possible further disciplinary action

Lunch Time Procedures

- **Start of Lunch**

- Proceed to the lunch room from your class (3rd or 4th). Hanging out at lockers is not permitted
- Please walk to and from the cafeteria
- Once seated wait for your table to be dismissed before leaving your seat

- **End of Lunch**

- Restrooms should be used during lunch
- Students are dismissed by table, tables and the floor surrounding your area should be picked up and trash free
- Students will exit through the main cafeteria doors into the quad
- Wait for the bell to ring and walk to class.

Cafeteria Expectations

- **Lunch Lines**
 - Stand on the blue colored tile lines (only one student may be served at the window at a time).
 - Do not take/give cuts, save places, or buy food for others.
 - Do not horseplay in line.
 - Go to the assigned lunch lines for your section **ONLY**.
 - Go to the lunch line **ONLY** when your section is released.
 - Do not “wait” for the lines to go down and then get in line.
- **Lunch Tables**
 - Remain seated when not in line. NO saving seats. Place your belongings at your own seat.
 - Use good table manners, and do not touch another student’s food.
 - Keep legs under table.
 - Keep the noise level down.
 - Clean up your eating area after you have finished.
 - Place all trash in the trash cans. Students are responsible for their own trash items to be placed in the garbage can.
 - No food/drink outside or in the restrooms.

Students who do not follow the cafeteria rules are subject to disciplinary action

Courtyard/Hall/Quad Expectations

- Students are allowed to enter Rogich Middle School at 8:52 AM and must exit campus by 4:15 PM
- Students should walk
- No pushing or horse playing
- Keep your hands to yourself
- Use appropriate language suitable for school
- No gum
- Do not take photos/videos of other students

Cheating/Plagiarism

- When you cheat, you cheat yourself!
- Keep your eyes to your own work
- Use your own ideas and words on your work
- Put your name on your own work ONLY!

Conflict Resolution Suggestions

- Talk to the counselor or social worker
- Do not send/post things through social media
- If you are not directly involved, avoid the situation
- If you are not sure how to handle the situation ask a trusted adult

Expulsion

- Assault to staff
- Assault to others
- Distribution of a controlled substance
- Weapons

Buses

- Know your bus route, cross streets and address
- A seating chart will be enforced
- Buses will depart within 6 minutes after school
- You must be registered with CCSD transportation to ride the bus
- Students who misbehave on the bus will receive consequences from Rogich Administration

Late Bus

- Arrives at 4:15
- Departs at 4:25
- You must receive a pass from your activities advisor or teacher to ride the late bus
- Passes will be collected by the bus driver

Transportation

- Student may be dropped off by parent/guardian, walk or ride their bike
- Bikes must be walked in the parking lot and locked inside the bike rack
- Students are responsible for securing their own bikes
- No skateboards, scooters, electronic or motorized scooters/mopeds, or roller blades are allowed

8th Grade Picnic & Dance

- Any student who has been in In-House suspension or suspended from school will not be allowed to attend these events
- Students must have a 1.0 GPA to be able to attend these events
